

## **OrgaTech supported the Association for Business Development North Rhine-Westphalia (Gesellschaft für Wirtschaftsförderung Nordrhein-Westfalen mbH - GfW) during the introduction of an integrated project management method**

The objective of this project consisted in offering qualified project management training to about 35 employees with simultaneous implementation of standardised project advancement for the complete handling of processes at GfW.

In order to reach the objective of a consistent project execution the main emphasis of the project was placed on the optimisation of processes and on working out the qualification measure with the staff of the Association for Business Development in an integrative way. So process analyses were documented in teamwork during workshops and then they were processed in seminars according to the new way of proceeding. Here the approach of project management was trained in a theoretical way and it was as well applied in real projects with day-to-day operations.

In the course of workshops an organisational analysis was carried out with the employees. This served as a preparation for the practice-oriented training seminars with a scope of 4 days in three groups and it allowed deriving practical and target-oriented measures from the results. Besides this qualification measure the documentation of a „Project Management Manual“ for everyday use was an output of the project.
